



### WELCOME TO THE BOB DEVANEY SPORTS CENTER

Entrances to the Devaney Center are located on the North and South sides of the building. Both entrances feature court-level and concourse-level entrances and all are handicapped accessible. The player pass gate entrance is located at the ticket office on the northwest corner of the building, while the media entrance is located on the court level of the south side. Gates to the Devaney Center will open 90 minutes prior to tipoff during the regular season. All fans one year old and above must have a ticket to gain admission.

### THE GREATEST FANS IN COLLEGE ATHLETICS

Nebraska is proud to have the Greatest Fans in College Athletics. Please continue to be the best sports in college basketball, treating your neighbors, visiting friends and opponents with respect. Fans using loud, obscene or abusive language or engaging in any other conduct detrimental to the environment of enjoying an event will be asked to cease their conduct and may be subject to ejection from the Devaney Center.

No alcohol or illegal drugs may be brought into the Devaney Center. Fans observed breaking local laws are subject to ejection and criminal prosecution. For your safety and the safety of others, refrain from throwing objects onto the court. Inappropriate conduct, activity or any discourtesy will not be tolerated and should be reported to event staff or security at (402) 472-FANS or Athletic Events Office at (402) 472-1960.

### DIRECTIONS FROM LINCOLN MUNICIPAL AIRPORT

Exit the airport on W. Adams Street, the main road leading out to Cornhusker Highway. Follow W. Adams Street to the first stoplight and turn right on Cornhusker Highway. Follow Cornhusker Highway and take a right on 14th Street. Proceed on 14th Street and take a left on West Entrance Road to enter the state fairgrounds and Devaney Center.

### DIRECTIONS FROM OMAHA'S EPPLEY AIRPORT

Exit the airport to the stoplight and turn right onto Abbott Drive. Go approximately one mile to Storz Expressway (Abbott Drive turns into Storz Expressway). Proceed approximately three miles to I-480 South. Follow the signs onto I-80 West to Lincoln. Follow I-80 for approximately 60 miles and take the 27th Street Exit. Follow 27th Street south to Cornhusker Highway and turn right. Follow Cornhusker Highway and take a right onto 14th Street. Proceed on 14th Street and take a left on West Entrance Road.

### PROHIBITED ITEMS

The University of Nebraska reserves the right to examine the contents of any container brought into the Devaney Center. The following items are prohibited:

- ⊘ Coolers, large bags and backpacks
- ⊘ Any outside food or drink
- ⊘ Video cameras
- ⊘ Noise makers
- ⊘ Banners/flags on poles
- ⊘ Glass bottles and cans
- ⊘ Knives
- ⊘ Alcoholic beverages or controlled substances
- ⊘ Limited use of cameras and portable radios is permitted. **Flash photography is prohibited.** Game action may not be filmed. Consideration of other spectators is expected.
- ⊘ With the passage of a new concealed weapons law in the state of Nebraska, fans are reminded that concealed weapons are not allowed on the UNL campus and are prohibited at all collegiate sporting events.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

**Text Messaging with UNL Police:** Starting in 2009-10, fans at the Devaney Center will be able to utilize a new text-messaging reporting system to quickly summon the UNL Police. In case of emergencies or to report a disturbance in your area, send a SMS text message to 41513, keyword UNLPD. Then type in the complaint and location. Standard SMS text message rates apply. This is a two-way texting system that will allow the UNL Police to respond back, as needed.

**First Aid:** The Red Cross provides emergency medical services and the first aid station is located in the southwest corner of the concourse level.

**Restrooms:** Restrooms are located on the north and south sides of the court level and on the east and west ends of the concourse level. A handicap-only family restroom is located in the southeast corner of court level. An elevator is also located in the southeast corner of the building.

**No Smoking Policy:** Smoking is NOT permitted in the Devaney Center. If you choose to leave the building to smoke, you must have both your ticket stub and a hand stamp to re-enter the Devaney Center.

**Public Telephones & ATMs:** Public pay phones are located on the four corners of the concourse level and the court level. An ATM can be found on the northeast corner of the concourse level.

**Lost and Found:** If you have lost anything - or found a lost item - please report/return it to the nearest event staff member or police officer. All lost and found items will be kept until the end of the season. Items may be claimed by contacting the Athletic Events Office at (402) 472-1960.

**Will Call:** Will call tickets will be available for pickup at the Devaney Center ticket window, outside the north entrance at the top of the upper ramp, beginning 90 minutes prior to tipoff. Media will call is available at the media entrance on court level on the south side. A photo ID is required to pick up will call tickets.

### GAME DAY PARKING INFORMATION

Late in the fall, the Saltcreek Roadway extension out to 27th Street will be complete. It will allow fans to have additional access in and out of the Devaney Center parking areas. Please check [Huskers.com](http://Huskers.com) in November before coming to your first Husker game for more information on traffic flow and parking around the Devaney Center.

### ENTERING AND EXITING YOUR LOT

- ▶ **Lot 1** - Enter from Antelope Valley Parkway (formerly 14th Street) onto West Entrance Road. Exit to Antelope Valley Parkway.
- ▶ **VIP Lot and Lots 2 & 4** - Enter from the west at the intersection of Military Road and Antelope Valley Parkway. Take a right to curve around the west side of the Devaney Center to Court Street. Please exit the same way you entered.
- ▶ **Lot 6** - Enter from Antelope Valley Parkway heading north. Exit to Antelope Valley Parkway heading north.
- ▶ **Lots 7 & 8** - Enter from Antelope Valley Parkway to West Entrance Road. Exit to West Entrance Road to Antelope Valley Parkway.
- ▶ **Lot 9** - Enter from 10th Street or Antelope Valley Parkway to Military Road. Exit to Antelope Valley Parkway heading north.
- ▶ **Public Parking Lots** - *From 27th Street:* Enter from the east on North State Park Drive, which winds around to the north side of the lot. Please exit the same way you entered. *From Military Road or Antelope Valley Parkway:* Enter the fairgrounds onto West Entrance Road. Proceed on West Entrance Road and head north (left) onto Journal Star Boulevard. Proceed on Journal Star Boulevard and take your first right. Please exit the same way you entered.

### ENTERING & EXITING THE DEVANEY CENTER

The Devaney Center can be reached from the west and east, and the addition of the Antelope Valley overpass allows visitors to bypass the train tracks on the south side. The entrance at 17th Street is permanently closed. Fans are encouraged to come early.

Fans trying to reach all lots are encouraged to enter from Antelope Valley Parkway or from Military Road. Fans from the south can reach Antelope Valley Parkway via an overpass on Salt Creek Roadway or from the new entrance from Vine Street. Access to public parking can be found coming from Antelope Valley Parkway or 27th Street.

### DISABLED PARKING

Disabled parking is available on a first-come, first-served basis on the east and south sides in Lots 2 & 4. Patrons must have a state-issued hang tag or license plate. Improperly parked vehicles or those found in a restricted area will be towed at owner's expense. Towed vehicles may be claimed by contacting the UNL Police at (402) 472-2222.
