Did You Know?

There is no overnight parking allowed in any donor lot; however, fans wanting to arrive early can enter the donor lots six (6) hours prior to kickoff.

How To Reach Your Lot

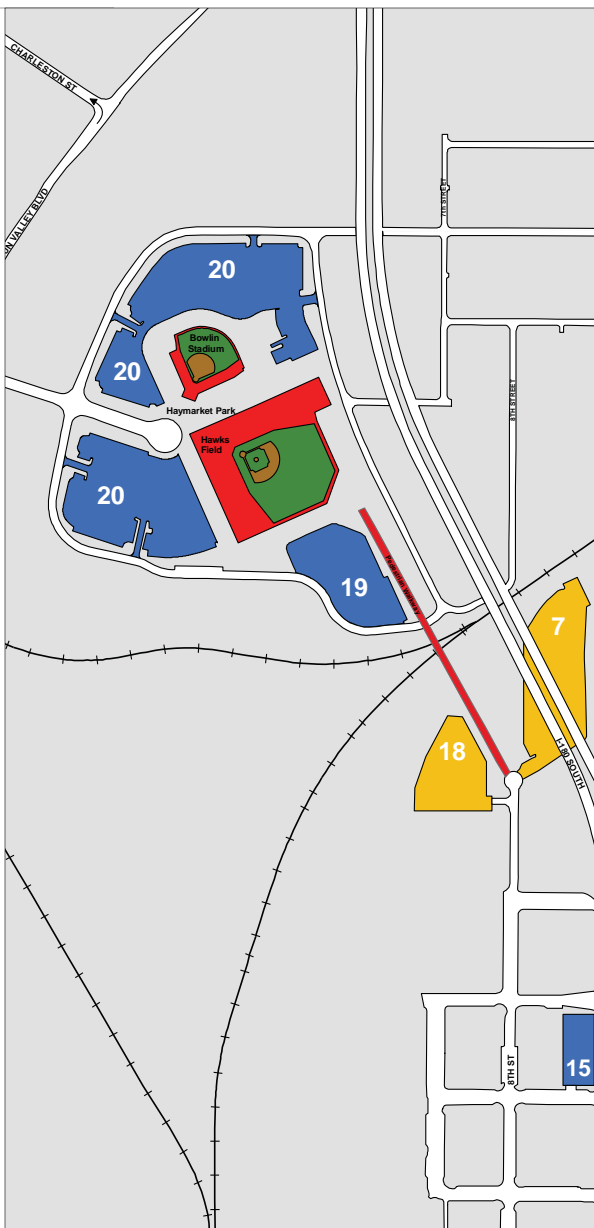
- ** Lot 1 -- Enter and exit from 10th and T
- Lot 2 -- Enter and exit from 11th and Q
- Lot 3 -- Enter and exit from 10th and T
- Lot 4 (closes 90 minutes before kickoff) -- Enter and exit from 10th and T
- Lot 5 -- Enter and exit from Salt Creek Roadway eastbound
- Lot 6 (closes 90 minutes before kickoff) -- Enter and exit from 10th and T
- Lot 7 -- Enter and exit from 8th and S
- Lot 8 -- Enter and exit from Salt Creek Roadway eastbound
- ** Lot 9 -- Enter from 14th and exit northbound over Big T
- Lot 10 -- Enter and exit from 16th or W
- Lot 12 -- Enter from 14th and Vine, and exit Vine Eastbound
- Lot 13 -- Enter from 10th, and exit on 11th and Q
- ** Lot 14 -- Enter and exit from 11th and Q
- ** Lot 15 -- Enter from 9th and exit on Q
- ** Lot 16 -- Enter from 10th and exit on Q
- Lot 18 -- Enter and exit from 8th and S
- Lot 19 -- Enter and exit from Sun Valley Blvd. and Line Drive (turn South to enter)
- Lot 20 -- Enter and exit from Sun Valley Blvd. and Line Drive (turn North or South to enter)

**No open fires and no electricity provided in the parking garages

Special Safety Note

As a safety precaution, BNSF Railway has fenced off the train tracks at Salt Creek Roadway (formerly Holdrege) and 14th Street. It is considered private property and crossing is illegal.

Fans should make other arrangements to reach Memorial Stadium, including the use of the bike path from the Devaney Center or the 10th Street pedestrian bridge.



Directions From Lincoln Municipal Airport:

Turn right on Northwest 12th Street as you drive out of the airport. Northwest 12th becomes Cornhusker Highway, which intersects with Interstate 180. Exit south (downtown) onto I-180, which turns into one-way, southbound Ninth Street in downtown Lincoln. Turn left at P Street (just past the Lincoln Journal Star building), go one block and turn left on 10th Street, then keep to the right for four blocks to Memorial Stadium (DO NOT enter I-180 north).



PARKING POLICIES AND STADIUM INFO

Parking Policies

Game-day parking for all lots directly surrounding Memorial Stadium is reserved for Nebraska Athletic Department donors. Donors who have previously requested and paid for parking permits will receive the passes in the mail before the season. Improperly parked vehicles or those found in a restricted area will be towed at the owner's expense. Towed vehicles may be claimed by contacting the UNL Police at (402) 472-2222. No overnight parking is allowed in the donor lots. The lots will open six (6) hours prior to kickoff of each game.

Disabled Parking

Parking for the disabled is available on campus on a first-come first-served basis for a \$15 fee per car. Booster Lots 5, 9 and 12 have spaces reserved for those with state-issued handicap parking tags or license plates. Ten extra-wide stalls, reserved for lift-equipped vans are available in Lot 5. Booster Lots 5 and 9 have free cart shuttle service for persons with disabilities to Memorial Stadium. Lot 8 has spaces for the disabled and pre-assigned stalls for lift-equipped vans, but will not be a game-day cash-only lot. Free public parking for the disabled is available at hooded meter spots on 14th and Vine. Additional public parking for the disabled is available at 17th and R streets, for \$15 per game. This lot is 10 blocks from the stadium, but has a free bus shuttle service that runs throughout the game to the East side of the stadium and generally does not reach capacity.

StarTran

Fans are encouraged to use the convenient game-day shuttle service through StarTran. Shuttle service to and from East Stadium begins *two and a half hours before kickoff* with the last shuttle running 45 minutes before kickoff. Shuttles will return to the lots immediately after the game.
