- Nebraska has won 10 consecutive meetings, including all eight matchups as Big 12 foes.
- Baylor is 4-8 all-time on Halloween, losing four straight such games. The Bears have not won on Halloween since a 25-7 victory against TCU in 1936.

TEAM NOTES

- Baylor has lost 23 consecutive games when trailing at halftime. The last time Baylor overcame a halftime deficit was Oct. 21, 2006, against Kansas when the Bears overcame a 35-17 halftime deficit for a 36-35 victory.
- Baylor falls to 7-1 in the **Art Briles** era when allowing 21 or fewer points.
- Baylor drops to 6-1 in the Briles era when allowing fewer than 20 first downs.
- Baylor was held scoreless in the first half for the second consecutive game. The Bears have been out-scored 65-10 in the first half of four Big 12 games this season.
- Baylor has not scored a first-half touchdown in three straight games.
- The Bears have not scored a first-quarter touchdown in four straight games.
- Baylor failed to score an offensive touchdown in the first three quarters for the third consecutive game.
- Baylor failed to score an offensive touchdown in a Big 12 Conference for the first time since Oct. 13, 2007, at Kansas.
- Baylor held an opponent scoreless in the second half for the first time since Sept. 6, 2008, vs. Northwestern State.
- Baylor held Nebraska to 273 total yards of offense, holding an opponent to less than 300 total yards offense for the first time since Sept. 26 against Northwestern State (248).
- Baylor held Nebraska to 128 yards passing, holding an opponent to less than 150 passing yards for the first time since Sept. 5 at Wake Forest (115).

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- LB **Joe Pawelek** started his 41st consecutive game, the longest streak by a Baylor player since **Maurice Lane's** school-record, 45-game streak that ran from 2002 to 2005.
- RG **James Barnard**, FS **Jordan Lake** and C **J.D. Walton** all started their 32nd consecutive games.
- LB **Antonio Jones** started his 20th consecutive game.
- WR **David Gettis** started his 16th consecutive game.
- IR **Kendall Wright** has caught at least one pass in each game of his career, a 20-game streak.
- TE **Justin Akers** has caught at least one pass in 11 consecutive games.
- Pawelek moved into second place on Baylor's career tackles list; he now has 388 career tackles.
- Pawelek moved into 24th place on the NCAA FBS career tackles list.
- CB **Clifton Odom's** third-quarter interception was the first of his career and resulted in his first career touchdown.
- Odom's interception return for a touchdown was Baylor's third this season. **Jason Lamb** and **Chance Casey** each accomplished the feat against Northwestern State.
- Gettis moved into ninth place on Baylor's career receptions list (95).
- Gettis set career high in single-game receiving yards (124).
- Wright moved into 11th place on Baylor's career receptions list (90).
- Wright has six games with at least four receptions this season.

Nebraska Postgame Notes

Nebraska vs. Baylor—Oct. 31, 2009

Nebraska 20, Baylor 10

- Nebraska improved to 11-1 all-time against Baylor with today's victory, including a 4-0 mark in Waco. Nebraska has won the past 10 meetings between the teams.
- The win gave Nebraska a 17-1 all-time record in games played on Halloween, and ended NU's three-game losing streak in the state of Texas (2007 Cotton Bowl, 2007 at Texas, 2008 at Texas Tech).
- Nebraska true freshman quarterback **Cody Green** made his first career start in today's game. Green is the first true freshman quarterback to start for Nebraska since Tommie Frazier started the final seven games in 1992. Frazier made his first career start in a 34-24 Nebraska win at Missouri on Oct. 24, 1992. Frazier and Green are the only true freshman quarterbacks to start for Nebraska.
- Green completed 12-of-21 passes for 128 yards and had an interception. He also rushed for 43 yards on eight carries.
- True freshman running back **Dontrayevous Robinson** rushed 13 times for 61 yards and a touchdown in the game. Robinson's one-yard TD run in the second quarter was his second touchdown of the season. His 23-yard run in the first quarter was a season-long rush for Robinson.
- Nebraska sophomore defensive tackle **Jared Crick** finished the game with five sacks for 24 yards. The five sacks are a Nebraska school record, bettering the mark of four sacks previously accomplished five times, most recently by Mike Rucker against Texas Tech on Oct. 19, 1996.
- Crick had seven tackles for loss (28 yards) to tie the school record for TFLs in a game set originally by Jim Skow against Missouri in 1985. Crick now has a team-high 8.5 sacks on the season and has 13 tackles for loss. He had more TFLs in today's game than in his first seven games this year.
- Crick had 13 total tackles and added a pass breakup. His total tackles was a career high, bettering his previous best of eight tackles earlier this year vs. Iowa State.
- Nebraska true freshman **Eric Martin** blocked a punt following Baylor's opening drive. Redshirt freshman **Justin Blatchford** returned the block 25 yards for a touchdown, marking the first blocked punt return for a touchdown by Nebraska since Adam Ickes returned a punt for a score against Missouri in Lincoln in 2004. Andrew Shanle blocked the punt vs. Mizzou.
- Nebraska senior defensive tackle **Ndamukong Suh** finished the game with five tackles, including three tackles for loss. Today's game marked his 12th straight game with at least one tackle for loss and the 18th time in the past 19 games he has had at least one tackle behind the line of scrimmage.
- Suh's tackle for loss today pushed his career total to 46, moving him up to third on the NU career tackles for loss list. His 1.0 sack moved him into seventh place on the NU career list as he now has 17.5 career sacks. He has 5.0 sacks on the year while adding 13 tackles for loss in 2009. Suh added two quarterback hurries today to give him 14 on the season.
- Nebraska junior place-kicker **Alex Henery** connected on a 45-yard field goal in the first quarter, followed by a 22-yarder in the second quarter. Henery has now connected on 24 consecutive field goals from inside 50 yards. Henery has three games this season with two or more field goals (VT, ULL) and eight multiple field goal games in his career.
- Henery has made 11-of-13 field goals this season and 37-of-42 in his career.
- Junior defensive backs **Dejon Gomes** and **Prince Amukamara** each intercepted a Baylor pass in the first half. The two are tied for the team lead with two each. Gomes' first interception came in the fourth quarter at Missouri, while Amukamara had a pick against Florida Atlantic.

- Junior wide receiver **Niles Paul** caught a 45-yard pass in the second quarter to set up a Nebraska touchdown. The 45-yard catch was the fifth of 20 yards or longer for Paul this season. He finished the day with 85 all-purpose yards.
- Nebraska was a plus-1 in turnover margin in today's game. In five wins this season the Huskers are plus-8, while the Huskers are -12 in turnover margin in their three losses.
- The Nebraska defense allowed a season-low tying 222 total yards against Baylor, marking the seventh straight opponent NU has limited to fewer than 280 yards. Nebraska has also held four straight conference foes to less than 300 yards for the first time since 1996.
- The Blackshirt defense allowed Baylor 10 points in the game. The Huskers have limited six of eight opponents to 16 or fewer points and have allowed just 90 points through eight games. Nebraska has allowed just eight offensive touchdowns in eight games, including only three passing touchdowns.
- Baylor picked up just 54 rushing yards on 32 carries to mark the seventh time in its last 10 games NU has allowed 102 or fewer rushing yards. The Bears averaged just 1.7 yards per carry, the sixth straight opponent to average fewer than 3.0 yards per rush against NU. Nebraska has not allowed a rush of longer than 23 yards in Big 12 play.
- Nebraska set a season-high with 7.0 sacks for 30 yards, bettering the mark of 5.0 sacks for 42 yards vs. Texas Tech. Nebraska has four games with at least four sacks this season and has 25 sacks on the season.
- Nebraska opened a 20-0 halftime lead today before Baylor posted a third-quarter field goal. Today's game marked the first time in eight games against BCS Conference foes that Nebraska scored first. The last time NU had scored first against a BCS foe was last season against Kansas.
- Tight end **Kyler Reed** had a career-long 22-yard reception in the first quarter.

Baylor Head Coach Art Briles

Opening statement...

"I'm proud of our guys for the way they fought the entire game. It couldn't have started out any worse than it did. I don't think you have to be a football follower for years to understand that that isn't how you want to start a football game, especially against a team that has a pretty good defense and when you haven't been as productive offensively as you'd like to be. That in itself set us back and I am just proud that our guys continued to fight."

On forcing turnovers...

"They're huge. You have to have them. I can draw anything on the board and show you how to stop it and score points, but field position, momentum and turnovers; that's what wins football games. If you can win those three things you can win football games."

On being able to build off of the second half...

"Yes and no. Yes by the way our guys have continued to fight hard for each other and for the university. The other part is that we can't play a quarter, we can't play a half, we have to play a game. We have to come out and play with the energy and emotion that we created in the fourth quarter or late in the third starting the football game. We have to make good things happen early."

On momentum built after Clifton Odom's touchdown late in the third...

"All of a sudden people feeling bad are feeling good. The crowd's excited, our sideline is excited and all of a sudden they aren't swallowing as easy on the other sideline. It changes everything and we gave ourselves opportunities, we just have to finish it out. We had good chances late and we have to make it happen and today we didn't make it happen. We have to load up, go to Missouri and win that game. We're growing as a team."

Freshman Quarterback Nick Florence

On the outcome of the game...

"It is frustrating. A play slips through your hands. We had plays at the end and we didn't do it. We fought hard in the second half, it was a valiant effort, but it does hurt when it was so close."

On his performance...

"In the first half I did not do very well. In the second half I did well, I thought. I mean there is always room to improve, so that is what we are going to do next week. I felt like second half we did stuff with the football, now we just have to punch it in."

On the defense's play...

"Hats off to the defense. They didn't give up a point in the second half. They got the turnover and got seven points. They did their job, now it is on us."

Senior Linebacker Joe Pawelek

On the defense's play...

"We preached getting turnovers through the week and came up with two turnovers in the second half, but I think more than anything we have just got to get off to a better start."

On Clifton Odom's interception...

"It was a huge, game changing play. That is what we have been talking about that we need, someone to step up and make that big play. Cliff read the route and made a great play and scored, so it was a huge play for us."

On the halftime turnaround...

"More than anything I think it was everyone doing their responsibilities. As you can see, when all 11 guys are out there doing what they are supposed to be doing we change the momentum and things get going out there. We have the capability to be a great defense out there."

Junior Cornerback Clifton Odom

On defensive adjustments at half...

"No big adjustments. We just came in and played how we should have been playing the whole season. It was good coming out but we have to play like that the whole game. We can't just play like that for a half."

On the interception...

"I was just in the right place at the right time. It happened so fast, I was definitely thinking about taking it to the house. I think it was a pretty big play. It got us going."

Senior Wide Receiver David Gettis

On being a big part of the offense in the second half...

"It was just what the defense was giving us. They just played a lot of man-to-man coverage. We just took advantage of it. I think the quarterback (Nick Florence) just did a great job of reading who was open. It just came down to the receivers making plays."

On how to turnaround the season...

"Get in the endzone. Period. Get in the endzone."

On the defense's play...

"They did a great job of getting us the ball and holding them to minimum yardage. All it really comes down to is us getting in the end zone and we have to do a better job of producing."

Nebraska Head Coach Bo Pelini

Opening statement...

"Anytime you go on the road and win it is an accomplishment. It was a good win for our guys. It was a win. We won the football game."

On Cody Green's interception that was returned for a touchdown...

"He made a mistake. That guy is trying to make a play and he just made a mistake. He made a bad throw and (Baylor) took advantage of it. Good for them."

On the play of Jared Crick...

"He played well. They turned their center to (Ndamukong) Suh and they were trying to double-team Suh, and (Jared Crick) took advantage of it. He is too good of a football player if they are going to do that. He did a good job and he played a great game."

On the defensive stops in the second half...

"You have to do what you have to do to win a football game. We did that on the defensive side of the ball. We didn't play our best football in any phase in the second half of the football game. We have a long way to go and we have a lot of work to do."

On the importance of the blocked punt returned for a touchdown...

"That was really big for us. It got us momentum. When you are starting Cody (Green) it takes the pressure off of him a bit. Anytime that you score a touchdown, especially on special teams, it is a big play."

QUARTERBACK CODY GREEN

On the game...

"In the first half things were rolling pretty good for us; everybody was making plays on both offense and defense. Those first couple of drives for us ended up in field goals when we wanted touchdowns, but any points is better than no points. In the second half we just went out there and just shot blanks. We were lucky enough that our defense came up big in the second half. In games like this you can't really go out and shoot blanks like this. We just have to go back to work."

On his interception...

"It was just a late throw on my part. If I had thrown it a second earlier it would have been a completion, but I threw it a second later and it was an interception for a pick-six. One thing you have to do is go back on the next drive and just forget about it. You have to have a memory like a goldfish."

On the importance of having a blocked punt prior to taking the field...

"That just takes a little bit of pressure off of me and (the pressure) likely goes to Baylor on that one. It is really good going out there knowing that you have a 7-0 lead before you set foot on the field. I have to give the special teams credit for that one. It was a great play and just a player making plays, that's about it."

DEFENSIVE TACKLE JARED CRICK

On establishing a school-record five sacks...

"It was a big game for all of us up front and the defense as a whole. I really can't take any credit (for the sacks), it is just the guys up front doing work. I have to credit (Ndamukong) Suh, Barry Turner and Pierre Allen for helping collapse the pocket with me. We just had some good breaks and a lot of good things happened today."

On the defensive pressure...

"They were double-teaming (Ndamukong) Suh most of the game so that gave me the opportunity to go one-on-one with the open lanes to kind of free rush. It could have been anyone today with all of those stats. It is just a group effort."

On shutting down the Baylor offense in the second-half...

"That is our goal, to keep them from scoring. They put up a field goal on us, but stuff like that happens and you just have to move on to the next play in the next series and just keep going."
