John Walker - Head Coach

John Walker brings a wealth of collegiate and international experience to the Nebraska program. Walker has led NU to 10 top-25 national rankings and 10 trips to the NCAA Tournament, including eight Sweet 16 bids and two trips to the Elite Eight. Walker guided

the Huskers to Big 12 regular-season titles in 1996, 1999 and 2000 and Big 12 Tournament titles in 1996, 1998, 1999, 2000 and 2002.

Wally Crittenden has been NU's goalkeeper coach for the past two seasons, facilitating nine shutouts over that time. Previously, Crittenden helped coach Big 12-rival Oklahoma to 14 shutouts in 2005-06, and was earlier active at various levels of soccer, including

high school, Olympic Development and Division II. Crittenden has been a member of the Under-20 U.S. National Team and has competed professionally.

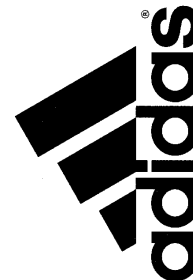
