HUSKERS PREPARED TO FACE THREE TOP-SIX TEAMS

The No. 5 Nebraska men's gymnastics team head to California to face three top-ten teams at the Stanford Open. The Huskers will face No. 3 Stanford, No.4 Oklahoma and No. 6 Stanford at the Burnham Pavilion Saturday night. The meet is slated to start and 9 p.m. No live stats or video will be available. No. 3 Stanford looks to continue their winning streak after shutting out No. 6 California on the road. Sophomore Sean Senters recorded a team-high 15.05 on vault and six different gymnasts earned event titles at the meet.

LOOKING AHEAD

The Huskers will hit the road for the west coast next weekend, facing No. 3 Stanford, No. 4 Oklahoma and No. 6 California at the Stanford Open in Palo Alto, Calif. The meet is slated for a 7 p.m. PT (9 p.m. CT) start on Saturday, Jan. 19.

LAST TIME OUT: HUSKERS FINISH STRONG AT SEASON OPENER

Nebraska battled with No. 3 Oklahoma throughout the Rocky Mountain Open, falling by 4.6 points. The Sooners edged out NU in the last three rotations, finishing with a score of 423.500-418.900 at the Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs, Colo., on Jan. 12.

Junior C.J. Schaaf led the Huskers as their only all-around competitor. Schaaf (80.900) claimed second overall in the all-around, falling behind Oklahoma's Alec Robin (80.950) by 0.05 points.

Sophomore Louis Klein also helped carry the team, competing in every event except pommel horse. Klein's strong performances peaked in a 13.65 on high bar, tying him for third overall on the event with teammate Mark Ringle.

NU saw its strongest performance on horse in an opener, tallying up an event total of 70.400. Freshman Ethan Lottman received the team's second-highest score on the event (14.70) behind junior Wyatt Aycock (14.75).

The Huskers fell behind on parallel bars and high bar, normally two of the team's strongest events. On parallel bars, Nebraska saw difficulties with their dismounts, leaving them with a team score of 69.400 on the event. The Big Red then moved to high bar, where they saw their lowest event total of the night (66.200). High bar specialist Micah Christensen struggled on his routine, finishing with a mark of 12.55.

NEBRASKA BREAKS TOP 5 IN NATIONAL RANKINGS

NU jumped to No. 5 nationally after placing second at their season opener against Oklahoma, Air Force and Arizona State on Saturday. The Huskers started the season ranked No. 9, seventh in the Big Ten. They jumped in the ranks after the first week of the season, along with Penn State, who claimed the top spot with a team score of 447.850. Illinois took the runner-up position (425.450), Stanford moved to No. 3 (425.000) and Oklahoma dropped to fourth (423.500). The Big Red is ranked third in the Big Ten, behind Penn State and Illinois.

Nebraska claimed the third spot on pommel horse and placed in the top five on floor, rings, vault and parallel bars. The Huskers just missed the top five on high bar, finishing sixth with a 66.200.

Individually, NU placed three athletes in event top ten rankings. Sophomore Andrew House claimed the No. 10 spot on floor after earning a 14.60 in Colorado Springs, Colo. Louis Klein and Grant Perdue also finished within the top 20 on floor, placing eleventh and eighteenth respectively.

Junior Wyatt Aycock (14.75) and freshman Ethan Lottman (14.70) led the team on pommel horse, claiming ninth and tenth respectively. The Huskers also saw gymnasts place on rings (Baier; tied 17), vault (Perdue; tied 12, Aycock and House; tied 18), parallel bars (Schryver; tied 15, Aycock; 18, Klein; tied 20) and high bar (Ringle and Klein; tied 16).

C.J. Schaaf topped the individual honors for the Huskers, earning fifth in the national all-around with an 80.900.

2012 PREVIEW

With the loss of a strong core of four seniors, the Huskers will look to improve upon their ninth place finish at the NCAA Championships. Will Eastman and Andreas Hofer left crucial positions on the team for the 2013 Huskers to pick up. Head Coach Chuck Chmelka expects the young team to move up in their absence.

In 2013, NU's men's gymnastics aims to improve on its first season in the Big Ten. The conference's tradition of strength and talent in men's gymnastics provides a challenging season for the Huskers. Chmelka said the consistent challenge should result in major growth from the more experienced Huskers, resulting in a strong postseason finish.

"I expect to have a steady, consistent season where our team builds from meet to meet and peaks at the NCAA Championships," Chmelka said.

Seniors Provide Foundation

Wyatt Baier's high level of experience on vault, floor and rings will lead the way for NU.

Fellow senior Gabriel Sanchez also adds leadership to the team and may be seen in three events throughout the season.

Junior Strength

Nebraska's six juniors have the ability to make major contributions to the lineup in 2013. Donovan Arndt returns after finishing his sophomore campaign by reaching the NCAA Individual Semifinals on still rings. He plans to continue on rings this season and may also appear on pommel horse.

Eric Schryver returns after tying for 10th on pommel horse at the 2012 Visa Championships. Strong on two other events as well, Schryver is expected to continue improving as he contends for All-America honors on horse this season.

After making limited appearances last season, Micah Christiansen aims to expand his competition time this season. Christiansen has trianed on floor exercise and vault and could break into the lineup on both events.

Mark Ringle competed regularly in three events throughout 2012 and is prepared to return for a solid junior season. Ringle is one of Nebraska's top returners on parallel bars and anchors NU's efforts on the event this season.

C.J. Schaaf aims take the next step in his career on three events. Schaaf has been a mainstay in the Husker lineup and has the capability to be one of NU's top competitors.

A standout as a freshman, Wyatt Aycock finished his sophomore season strong, competing in three events for the Huskers at the NCAA Team Qualifiers. Aycock returns in hopes of claiming All-America honors in the all-around, pommel horse or parallel bars.

Zach Hedval, the team's newest addition, arrives at Nebraska from Grossmont College in El Cajon, Calif. Hedval has the potential to make an immediate impact on rings for the Huskers.

Sophomore Standouts

Grant Perdue leads the eight returning Husker sophomores after earning All-America honors on floor exercise in 2012. He hopes to continue improving his scores on floor, vault and rings and could see action on high bar as well.

Hayden Henriouille was slowed late in his freshman season by a shoulder injury. Back to full strength in 2013, he has trained to continue his success on floor and parallel bars.

After suffering an season-ending injury last year, Andrew House will add several big routines to the Huskers' lineup in 2013. Teammates Robbie Kocks and Connor Stillwell also look to help the team's depth.

Gabriel Jolley has the ability to add more event titles to his collection after receiving his first for vault during his freshman season. Jolley hopes to expand his repertoire to five events in 2013.

Loaded with potential, Louis Klein has the capability to compete on as many as five Husker events this season. Coaches are especially excited about Klein's powerful floor routine, which could be one of NU's top performances.

Josh Ungar was impressive during his freshman season with the Big Red. He may challenge for a consistent spot on the team and hopes to add pommel horse and parallel bars this year.

Freshmen Factors

Redshirt freshman Ryan Irick looks to crack into competition this year after undergoing shoulder surgery last season. Irick will help the team on horse, rings and parallel bars.

True freshman Ethan Lottman brings excellent work on horse to the team and has the ability to crack the lineup immediately for the Huskers.

A solid performer on parallel bars, Sam Chamberlain is capable of making a big impact for the Huskers. He may also see time on high bar and rings for the Big Red.

One of NU's most exciting arrivals, Austin Epperson is limited this season after receiving surgery in 2012.

Coleman Tokar comes to Nebraska as a walk-on looking to increase his skills to compete at the collegiate level. Tokar gives NU depth on floor, rings and vault.

Challenging Schedule

The Huskers begin the 2013 season with two consecutive road meets, travelling to the Rocky Mountain Invitational on Jan. 12 before journeying to the Stanford Open on Jan. 19.

The Huskers open at home on Jan. 27 at 1 p.m., welcoming the University of Illinois-Chicago Flames to the Bob Devaney Sports Center.

NU will then hit the road for three straight meets, first traveling to Minnesota to face the Golden Gophers on Feb. 2. Qualifying Huskers will then head west to compete in the Winter Cup in Las Vegas, Nev., before making their way back to the Midwest to face Iowa on Feb. 23.

Nebraska will return home to face Oklahoma on Mar. 3, then celebrate Senior Day against Iowa and Minnesota at the Devaney Center on Mar. 16. The Huskers will close their regular season with a trip to face defending-NCAA champion Illinois in Champaign, Ill.

The Huskers kick off their postseason in Minneapolis, Minn., on April 5-6, competing in the Big Ten Championships against some of the nation's top talent. Nebraska's regular-season and conference-championship performances will determine whether the Big Red qualify for the NCAA Championships. The Championships will be hosted by Penn State on April 18-20 at University Park, Pa.
