Quarterback B.J. Coleman

On if he felt like he could move the football today

"I felt really good out there in terms of being able to complete the football and move the football throughout the field. I thought we did a really good job with moving the chains. Let's give credit to Nebraska's defense. They've got a great football team, especially defensively. I'm very proud of the way we fought, though. We came out and we took punch-for-punch with them coming out of the third quarter. That was really cool being able to drive down. I think it was an 80-yard drive for a touchdown. That's very impressive for us to be able to come out here and do that. I'm very impressed with both sides of the ball, though. Offensively, defensively and in special teams, I thought we did some good things."

On how well UTC's young offensive line played tonight

"Those guys are young. I think we had three brand new guys come in there and start for us. It was their very first start and it was in Memorial Stadium. So for them to come out and do what they did, I'm very proud of them. We have some things that we need to work on, obviously. The sacks and the ground game, that's on me, and I have to make sure we are ready to go for Jackson State next week. I'm very impressed with how they came out.
