Ohio State Football Postgame Notes

No. 6 Ohio State 62, No. 10 Nebraska 3

Saturday, Nov. 5, 2016

Ohio Stadium, Columbus, Ohio

Attendance: 108,750

- Ohio State head coach **Urban Meyer** improved to 162-28 in his career, continuing to hold the highest winning percentage among active coaches with at least 10 years of FBS coaching experience at .853.
- The attendance of 108,750 was the second-highest in Ohio Stadium history.
- The game marked the Buckeyes' first 50-point game against a Top 10 team since the No. 2 Buckeyes topped No. 4 Michigan, 50-14, Nov. 23, 1968. The 62 points are the most Ohio State has scored against a Top 10 team.
- Ohio State has won six of its last seven matchups against Top 10 opponents.
- With four more touchdown passes Saturday, **J.T. Barrett** has been responsible for 94 career touchdowns, the second-highest mark in the Big Ten dating back to 1996 behind Drew Brees' 95.
- Barrett tied his career high with 26 completions on a career-high 38 attempts. Both previous highs were recorded against Cincinnati Sept. 27, 2014.
- The Buckeyes' 32 completions tied for the second-most in school history. Ohio State also completed 32 passes at Penn State in 1997. The school record is 34 completions at Indiana in 1998.
- **Damon Webb**'s first-quarter interception was the first of his career. Webb returned the interception for a touchdown, marking the first interception return for a touchdown since Jerome Baker took a pick 68 yards for a score at Oklahoma Sept. 17.
- **Malik Hooker** later returned an interception 48 yards for a touchdown, marking the second time Ohio State recorded two interceptions for a touchdown in a game this season. Hooker and **Marshon Lattimore** each returned an interception for a touchdown against Tulsa Sept. 10.
- The Buckeyes' six defensive touchdowns this season tie the 2014 Buckeyes for most defensive scores by a Big Ten team in the last 10 seasons. The Buckeyes' six interceptions for a touchdown set a program record. The previous mark was four, set by the 1987 Buckeyes and later tied by the 1996 team.
- Hooker is the second Buckeye in program history with two interception returns for a touchdown in a season after Neal Colzie accomplished the feat in 1973. Hooker becomes the ninth Buckeye with two career interception returns for a touchdown, a program record.
- **Terry McLaurin**'s seven-yard touchdown catch in the first quarter was the second touchdown reception of his career.
- **Mike Weber**'s 23-yard touchdown run in the second quarter was his team-high seventh rushing score of the year.
- **Curtis Samuel**'s two touchdowns receiving tied a career high set in the 2016 season-opener against Bowling Green Sept. 3.
- **Joe Burrow**'s 12-yard rushing touchdown was the first rushing touchdown of his career.
- **K.J. Hill** set career bests with five catches and 66 yards.
- **Michael Hill** tallied a career-high 1.5 tackles-for-loss.
- Ohio State improved to 16-4 in night games at Ohio Stadium and has won 14 of its past 15 night games overall.
