Maryland Player Quotes

Sophomore Wide Receiver D.J. Moore

On his 92 yard touchdown:

"I would say that's one of the best touchdowns I've had. The first time, I didn't know that two people [were] coming until I just looked at the video. So I just split them and I saw open grass on the right and I just ran to it."

On the difficulties Maryland has faced at the quarterback position:
